Action Plan for Lion Year 2008-2009:

To get as many clubs as possible to communicate the MMR and club activities to me via electronic methods.

This above goal has been so successful that I feel almost overwhelmed with e-mails by month's end now that Club Secretaries need to file reports no later than the last day of each month.

This has led me to thinking about possible solutions. An idea I'd like to try next Lion Year is "Region Correspondents/Reporters." It is hoped that I can acquire at least one, possibly two, Lions from each of the five regions in the District.

My search begins with an article in the Jan. 2009 Journal and a handout will also go into the envelope at the Feb. round of Region Meetings.

These Region Correspondents will handle news for clubs in their Regions, forwarding it to me as Editor-in-Chief. The Region Correspondents would not have an overwhelming amount of work to do and it is hoped that it will reduce my workload as well.

E-mail should make communication amongst the Correspondents and the Editor quite easy. I do think that it's something worth trying.

Seven monthly issues of the Journal have been published – from July 2008 through Jan. 2009. There have been three submissions of material to the IL State Magazine (Aug., Oct., and Dec. 2008), with the next one due in early Feb. 2009.

It has been my pleasure to serve District 1-J as its Editor of the 1-J Journal for yet another year. It is a great District to work with and represent.
