Like to write?

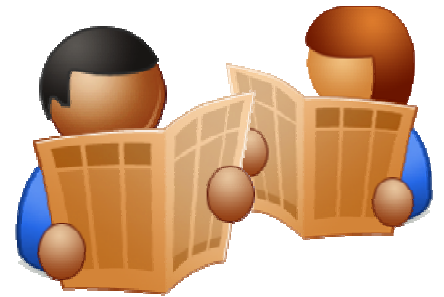
