What is Lions Quest?

Lions-Quest is a program that teaches Life Skills to student from grades K-12, it can be a stand-alone program, or it can be incorporated into the current curriculum. The Quest program teaches students how to be responsible citizens, the importance of staying away from self-destructive substances, self-discipline and how to resolve conflicts in a positive manner, how to handle test anxiety, just to name a few. The programs are taught in modules, depending on grade level, to address the challenges the student is most likely to face at that point in their lives.

The program requires that all Lions-Quest instructors be certified before teaching the curriculum, and therefore has many options available to schools / districts that wish to implement the program. In addition, all instructors are required to keep their certification current, thus ensuring the material they are teaching is not only current, but relevant to the situations the students may face.

As Lions and as citizens of our communities, it is our responsibility to ensure that our youth grow up to be responsible citizens, that is why the Quest program is so important. It is not just the “At Risk” kids that can benefit from the program, everyone can.

The program has 3 levels, all of which build on each other, when the student graduates, they will be well prepared for the many challenges they will meet, and will know how to properly deal with them. They will be better students in school, in many school districts – the average test scores have risen where Lions Quest programs are in place. This could be due to the higher values that program teaches, or the test preparation module in the program – or both. Either way – everyone wins with Lions Quest.
