I attended the last Camp Lions Visitation held July 31st at Camp Reynoldswood in Dixon before the three Camp Lions closed shop for the year. 72 Lions and friends came to the Reynoldswood Visitation to get a glimpse of the camp activities, enjoy the tour of the leafy campsite and interact with the youthful campers with hearing or vision impairment.

I attended the State Coordinators Meeting in Bloomington, IL Sunday, August 10. PDG Dick Sellers, State Camp Lions Coordinator reported 249 campers attended the summer Camp Lions this year, 57 campers were from District 1J Clubs.

On the financial side, Lion Mario Gumino reported as of July 27, 2009, District 1J topped the list of donations for Camp Lions with \$47,047.51, followed by District 1F with \$36,900 and District 1A with \$20,132.

Bartlett Lions Club topped the list of Camp Lions donors with \$15,800, followed by Geneva Lions with \$3,000 and Sun City-Huntley with \$2,500.

Our goal for the year is to drum up donations for Camp Lions by District 1J clubs by circulating Lion Mario's quarterly financial report on Camp Lions donations and work with the state coordinators in converting the Camp Lions PowerPoint presentation CD into a DVD format to make it easier for club members and non-Lions to know more about Camp Lions and its wonderful activities.
